## COVID-19 update for Improve your long game clubs

Cancer Council NSW is committed to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of Improve your long game clubs and the broader community. Based on current NSW Government advice, <u>clubs may allow the communal use of sunscreen</u> via the two sunscreen stands. As with other frequently touched areas and surfaces around the club, sunscreen pumps should be cleaned several times per day with disinfectant solution or wipes.

A club's decision to make sunscreen available to patrons should be made with consideration of their COVID-19 Safety Plan. In line with current NSW Government advice, we recommend that clubs:

- Clean and disinfect sunscreen pumps several times a day.
- Practice and encourage good personal hygiene, including frequent hand washing and use of sanitiser
- Ensure hand sanitiser is accessible throughout the club
- <u>Display posters and signage</u> as reminders to all staff, members and visitors of COVID-19 safe behaviours and new standards of etiquette

Alternatively, clubs may place sunscreen bottles in the bathroom or another place where golfers can wash their hands and/or sanitise before using or choose not to supply sunscreen at all. In this case, we suggest that clubs:

- Download and display our COVID-19 flyer on the sunscreen stands
- Encourage golfers to bring their own sunscreen to the course
- Remind golfers to wear a broad-brimmed hat and long-sleeved clothing using our <u>A5</u> <u>SunSmart Tips flyers</u>
- Display our <u>SunSmart App</u> poster to let players know how they can find out daily sun protection times and ensure they protect their skin during these times
