COVID-19 update for *Improve your long game clubs*

Given the evolving COVID-19 situation in NSW, our advice regarding the use of sunscreen via the Improve your long game stands has temporarily changed to help protect the health and safety of our community.

We strongly recommend that all clubs located in Greater Sydney temporarily remove sunscreen bottles from the metal sunscreen stands to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Should you decide to still provide sunscreen to patrons, place it where golfers can wash/sanitise their hands before and after use and clean the pump regularly with disinfectant solution or wipes.

We will update you should our advice change. In the meantime, we recommend that clubs:

- Print and display our [COVID-19 flyer](#) on the stands or in a location that is highly visible to golfers to help communicate this message to the club
- Encourage golfers to bring their own sunscreen to the course and wear protective clothing, a broad-brimmed hat, and sunglasses
- Encourage golfers to download the [free SunSmart App](#) so they can stay up to date with daily UV and know when sun protection is required

For clubs located in Regional NSW, you may continue to provide sunscreen via the sunscreen stands if you feel comfortable to do so. As with other frequently touched areas and surfaces around the club, sunscreen pumps should be cleaned several times per day with disinfectant solution or wipes. Please note, however, the situation can change and escalate quickly, so we encourage you to continue following the updates from [NSW Health](#) and make the decision to restrict access to communal sunscreen if necessary.
